- 2. I will obey time limits on online communication (set a timer next to the computer, ie. 45 minutes on Facebook, etc.).**

- 5. I won't say anything in cyberspace that I would feel uncomfortable saying face-to-face.**
- 6. I won't post my personal information online (address, phone number, school, whereabouts, etc.).**
- 7. I understand that any pictures I'd like to post online must first get approval from my parents.**
- 8. I understand that my YouTube usage and what I post on YouTube will be monitored by my parents.**
- 9. I understand that, when I go to a friend's house, I am still responsible for the ground rules my parents have put in place (even if my friend does not have ground rules). I know what the consequences are if any ground rules are broken.**
- 10. I understand that my parents will talk to me about appropriate online behavior and what works for me and my friends.**
